# Green Credentials Hat

A beanie hat that is designed to fit a larger head (as pictured) or for a slouchy fit with a smaller head. The contrast colour adds an element of interest

It is worked in the round.

This pattern is written only.

I used 4 seasons Pure Wool 8ply, but any 8ply yarn will work with this pattern.

## Difficulty and Terminology:

This is an easy pattern and uses US terminology.

## What You Will Need:

1 ball 8 ply (double knit yarn) in green (MC)  
1 ball 8 ply (double knit yarn) in dark green (CC)  
5 mm hook  
Tapestry needle (to weave in ends)

## Tension:

14 sts/8 rounds = 10cm/4 inches square in dc turning/without turning at the end of each round

## Sizing:

The hat has a circumference of 64cm and 22cm from tip to brim.

## Abbreviations:

ch - chain  
dc - double crochet  
slst - slip stitch



## **The Hat:**

To start ch 4 (counts as dc) with MC;

Round 1: work 11 dc in 1st chain, join with slip stitch in first dc; (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 1, 2 dc in each dc around, join with slip stitch in first dc; (24 dc)

Round 3: ch 1, \*dc in first dc, 2 dc in next dc\*, repeat \* to \* all around, join with slip stitch in first dc; (36 dc). Change colour to CC at the end of this row.

Round 4: ch 1, \*2 dc in first dc, dc in next 2 dc\*, repeat \* to \* all around, join with slip stitch in first dc; (48 dc). Change colour to MC at the end of this row.

Round 5: ch 1, \*2 dc in first dc, dc in next 3 dc\*, repeat \* to \* all around, join with slip stitch in first dc; (60 dc)

Round 6: ch 1, \*2 dc in first dc, dc in next 4 dc\*, repeat \* to \* all around, join with slip stitch in first dc; (72 dc)

Round 7: ch 1, \*2 dc in first dc, dc in next 5 dc\*, repeat \* to \* all around, join with slip stitch in first dc; (84 dc). Change colour to CC at the end of this row.

Round 8: ch 1, dc in each dc around, join with slip stitch in first dc. (84 dc). Change colour to MC at the end of this row.

Round 9 - 11: ch 1, dc in each dc around, join with slip stitch in first dc. (84 dc). Change colour to CC at the end of row 11.

Round 12: ch 1, dc in each dc around, join with slip stitch in first dc. (84 dc). Change colour to MC at the end of this row.

Round 13 - 15: ch 1, dc in each dc around, join with slip stitch in first dc. (84 dc). Change colour to CC at the end of row 15.

Round 16: ch 1, dc in each dc around, join with slip stitch in first dc. (84 dc)

## **Finishing**

Fasten off and weave in ends
