Crochet to Enhance Your World

Maillot Jaune

A crochet pattern for the grand cycle tour fan. As the name suggests it is for the yellow jersey of the Tour de France. It is made from a small amount of wool in the colour for the jersey you wish to make. The pattern lets you know what colours to use if you are not familiar with them. It is a must make for the cycling fan in your life.

It is worked in the round.

This pattern is written only.

I used 4 seasons Pure Wool 8ply, but any 8ply yarn will work with this pattern.

Difficulty and Terminology:

This is an intermediate pattern and uses US terminology.

What You Will Need:

4mm hook

8ply or double knit wool in yellow, or another colour as listed below

Tapestry needle (to weave in ends)

Tension:

16 sts/18 rounds = 10cm/4 inches square in sc turning/without turning at the end of each round

Sizing:

The jersey is about 7cm high, about 10cm wide at the arms, and about 2 cm wide when it is stood up.

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

slst - slip stitch



The Jersey:

Chain 12, join with slst to make a ring;

Round 1: ch 1, sc in each st around, join with slst in first sc; (12)

Round 2: this round is worked in the back loop only. ch1, sc in next 3 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc, 3sc in next sc, join with slst in first sc; (21)

Round 3: ch1, sc in next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc, 3sc in next 3 sc, 3sc in next sc, joint with slst in first sc; (27)

Round 4: ch1, sc in first 6 sc, skip 5 sc, sc in next 9sc, skip 5 sc sc in next 3 sc, join with slst in first sc; (18)

Round 5 - 12: ch1, sc in each sc around, join with slst in first sc; (18)

Sleeves

For each sleeve join under each arm, for three rounds sc in each st around.

Finishing

Fasten off and weave in ends
