



Card Holder

In this modern day cash is not something that I use much any more, cards are the order of the day. I wanted a compact holder for my cards, and came up with this card holder.

It holds ten cards that I use on a regular or semi regular basis, and is perfect for me.

This pattern can be used with 8ply cotton or two strands of 4ply cotton held together. This allows you to use the colour combination that you like best, or make several to match whatever you are wearing.

Difficulty and Terminology:

This is an intermediate pattern and uses US terminology.

What You Will Need:

3.25 mm hook

4 ply cotton (two strands held together)

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends



Tension:

22 st/22 rounds = 10 cm/4 inches square in sc without turning at the end of each round

Sizing:

The finished card holder is 9.5 cm wide and 6.5 cm long (closed), or 13 cm long (open)



Abbreviations:

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

slst - slip stitch

The Card Holder:

Round 1: ch14, 3sc into 2nd chain from hook, sc in each ch across, 6sc in last ch, working on other side of the foundation chain, sc in each ch across, 3sc in last ch, join with slst;



Round 2 - 13: ch1, sc in each sc around, join with slst;

Row 14: ch1, sc in next 19 sc, turn;

Row 14 - 28: ch1, sc in each sc across.

Finishing

Fasten off and weave in ends.
